MILESTONES OF HISTORY AND PMC

Historical background

1980

Dr. Mostafizur Rahman, a young doctor was dreaming to make his career in surgery and trying to get transfer in a training post in Dhaka. At this point, he could manage transfer from Thana Health Complex to Dhaka Medical College Hospital. The Dhaka Medical College Hospital authority posted him in Central Pathology Laboratory of the Hospital. Gradually he developed interest in pathology and continued his service there.

1983

Dr. Mostafizur Rahman established a diagnostic laboratory in the name of **Popular Diagnostic Centre Ltd.** with three small rooms at Elephant road, Dhaka with a promise to render best possible standard services to the people of the country at an affordable cost and in turn to limit the outflow of the patient abroad at the expense of hard earned foreign currency. He was doing well and progressively improving in his quality of service & performance. Later, he was transferred to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital in 1985. At this stage he decided to leave the government job and concentrate fully with his establishment. This was a turning point in his carrier planning and he never have to look back.

2002

Dr. Mostafizur Rahman started **Popular Pharmaceuticals Ltd.** in 2002. He purchased the then "Fisons Bangladesh Ltd." and appointed an Australian Consultant from Asia Pacific Company to make a master plan for the construction of a complete pharmaceutical factory plant. Within three years the construction was completed & it began producing quality medical products in July, 2005.

2009

To fulfill his dream to build up the "Popular Group" as the state of the art total health care provider of the country in the non-government sector Dr. Md. Mostafizur Rahman began a 250 bed hospital in the name of **Popular Specialized Hospital Ltd.** With the achievement of a well functioning hospital well wishers and admirers added fuel to his dream of establishing a medical college. On 9th September, 2009 in an Iftar party hosted by him to honour the medical specialists Dr. Mostfizur Rahman expressed his desire of establishing a medical college in the coming days. In his speech he also mentioned that Professor T. I. M. Abudllah-Al- Faruq would be the principal of the medical college. Everybody present in the party supported his desire with a big hand.

2010

On seventeenth February an advertisement for establishment of two new medical colleges in the private sector was floated in the national dailies. Dr. Mostafizur

Rahman rushed to Professor T. I. M. Abdullah-Al-Faruq showed the advertisement and expressed his keen desire to establish a medical college. Professor T. I. M. Abdullah-Al-Faruq observed that the session was almost over and classes had already begun in all the medical colleges. Prof. T. I. M. Abudullah-Al-Faruq explained to Dr. Mostafizur Rahman that a pioneer and perfectionist in diagnostic services and also in pharmaceuticals in this country must not proceed to establish medical college so hurriedly compromising the quality. It was imperative that the medical college began as a quality medical college from the outset. Dr. Mostafizur Rahman agreed with his proposal. From that very day an active planning of establishing a medical college was begun.

December 29, 2010

After 10 months of planned and active work **Popular Medical College** opened its door for the students on the 29th day of December, 2010 with Professor T. I. M. Abdullah-Al-Faruq as the founder Principal. The college was set up in a prime location of the Dhaka city where most of the civic facilities were present within 5 km radius of the college and the college campus was easily accessible by all types of transport.

The college started its activities with 3 departments of basic science subjects, 50 students and 19 teachers. At present the college consists of 25 departments/units. The number of students and teachers has increased to 600 and 148 respectively.

Within a few years, the college campus will be shifted to a new area at Mohammadpur near historic Martyr Intellectuals Memorial. For the complete campus complex, a total land of 121.63 Katha has been acquired. A comprehensive plan has been taken to build academic buildings, 750 bedded hospital building, student hostels, a nursing institute, a mosque, outdoor playground and many more. The modern architectural construction of PMC campus will be finished soon availing modern facilities & technology.

The concept of establishing of the college is to produce **“doctors with a difference capable of taking the charge of the future”**.

Since its inception the college has a distinctive character of having distinguished medical scholars of the country as faculties, who have enriched the pool of knowledge by making notable contributions in the fields of teaching-learning-assessment and research.

The high standard of education for the college was set by its faculties under the dynamic leadership of the Principal and Vice-Principal. While serving as a highest echelon of academic excellence the college functions additionally as a premise for co-curricular and extra-curricular activities that would lead the students and ultimately the nation towards progress. The college in striving to combine the pursuit of knowledge and truth with values and needs of an evolving society. The greatest possession and will of the faculties with unconditional support of the entrepreneur will definitely do more than anything else to increase and spread the form of Popular Medical college beyond the territory of Bangladesh.

The Popular Medical College is well prepared to meet the challenges of the coming days with its freedom of work, justice and truth as a foundation commitment to the objective envisaged by the founders.

The first child of Popular Medical College was delivered in 2016. After 5 years of hard work 96% students were declared to have passed the Final Professional MBBS Examination of January, 2016. Subsequent deliveries were also very comfortable. Until now eight batches have passed out and after successful completion of internship these young doctors have entered the greater field of humanitarian service and rendering service efficiently with confidence. Popular Medical College is proud of this promising young doctors.

Medical Education Unit

In early 19th century, teaching was regarded more of an art than a science. At that time teaching was mostly teacher dominated with very little emphasis on life long and self-directed learning. One became a teacher following the footsteps of their ancestor teachers. By the end of 19th century the question of training and practice to become a medical teacher arose.

Medical education in modern education system has shown great changes in different areas of teaching and assessment. Teaching aims to make a lifelong learner and assessment aims to reflect the integration of clinical and scientific learning, the nature of professionalism in clinical practice and role of a doctor in health care team. Adaptation to these changes demands continuous training and practice of medical education among faculty members to improve the quality of health care by improving the different areas of medical education.

During the early period of 2011 Popular Medical College established a Medical Education Cell with the objective to meet the health professionals need. To observe the objective, the cell attempted to improve teaching learning process and to establish standard, measurable evaluation system within a framework of quality assurance. The cell organized different seminars on different issues of medical education encompassing several subdivisions including teaching learning theories, instructional methodology, assessment and evaluation, clinical teaching and continuing medical education. As soon as it got momentum, the cell was transformed into Medical Education Unit in 2014. This was done in fulfillment of the requirement for National Quality Assurance Body (NQAB) to achieve a stronger quality assurance program.

Medical Education Unit has been trying to build capacity of medical teachers in all level to make a complete package team to provide medical education as need of today in association with global changes of science. As part of it the unit not only measures the activities of faculty development but also tries to identify ways of improvement of the learnt activities.

Faculty development was given priority by the authority to promote effective teaching learning and implementation of various assessment methods.

The primary goal of such endeavour was capacity building of young teachers of PMC. Dissemination of changes and advancement of educational science to teachers of medical institutes was in the background. Participation of interested teachers of different level of different medical institutes was sought to enhance effectiveness of educational programs through mutual interaction. Medical Education Unit takes part in Quality Assurance Program of PMC. MEU also encourage members of the unit and other faculty members to participate in seminars and other similar programs on Medical education in regional and national forums and conduct research in medical education and publish and present findings of their study.

Activities of medical education unit encompass teaching and learning process, assessment methods and research methods. Programs included seminars on regular basis and workshops of two or three days in different occasions and also interactive lectures to ensure better outcome. Workshops were also designed participatory ensuring involvement of each participants. Guest lecturers by eminent medical educationist from home and abroad were also arranged at different occasions. These were well attended and participated by teachers of PMC and other institutes.

Institutional Review Board (IRB)

It is designated to approve (or reject), monitor, and review biomedical and behavioral research involving humans.

IRBs are most commonly used for studies in the fields of health and the social sciences, including anthropology, sociology, and psychology. Such studies may be clinical trials of new drugs or medical devices, studies of personal or social behavior, opinions or attitudes, or studies of how health care is delivered and might be improved. Many types of research that involves humans, such as research into which teaching methods are appropriate, unstructured research such as oral histories, journalistic research, research conducted by private individuals, and research that does not involve human subjects, are not typically required to have IRB approval.

Research Cell Works

Popular Medical College has a vision to produce the quality doctors in the country. To keep pace with modern medical science, research is mandatory. To fulfill this Popular Medical College authority formed a Research Cell earlier. The formation of research cell reflects the commitment of the college towards modern education including the research. The Research Cell aims to foster, design and execute high quality multidisciplinary research in PMC. Plan of action includes initiation, facilitation, integration and support of research projects conducted by faculty members of the PMC.

The research cell is responsible for evaluating the scientific excellence of the submitted projects. The cell is also responsible for the allocation of research grants, when available.

The approved protocol requires ethical clearance by the Ethical Review Committee of Popular Medical College before final approval for research is granted by the cell.

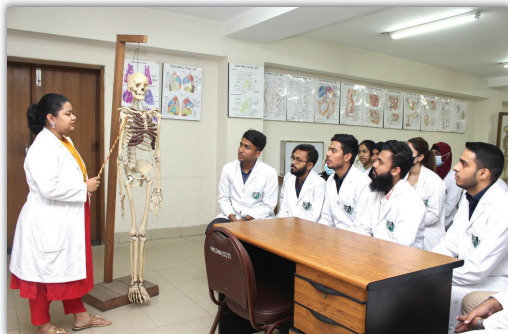
